



- · apply (CIA).








#### Part 1: Read Aloud







Sheltered instruction strategies to support readers at all levels include

- 1. clear objectives,
- 2. explicit instruction,
- 3. repetitive practice,
- 4. discussion stems,
- 5. collaboration with peers,
- 6. word walls,
- 7. anchor charts,
- 8. appropriate pacing,
- 9. differentiated instruction, and
- 10.scaffolding.
