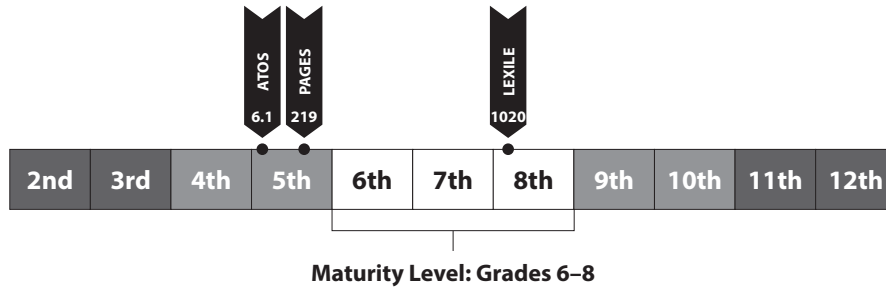


### All Thirteen Text Complexity
