QUALITATIVE MEASURES

Levels of Meaning

The text offers multiple levels of meaning and nuances of abstract concepts related to genocide, the Holocaust, immigration, and the Jewish culture.

Structure

This narrative is told mostly chronologically, with a flashback near the beginning of the book.

Language Conventionality and Clarity

The setting of this story adds some complexity to the language. Dialogue that incorporates historical and regional language makes this text qualitatively challenging.

Knowledge Demands

This text requires knowledge of the genre memoir. In addition, students will need to rely on background knowledge of the Holocaust.

QUANTITATIVE MEASURES

The Lexile level for *Four Perfect Pebbles* is 1080, based on word frequency and sentence length. This is in the lower range of the complexity band for 9th–10th grade according to the Common Core State Standards.

READER TASK CONSIDERATIONS

These should be determined locally with reference to motivation, knowledge, and experiences as well as to purpose and the complexity of the tasks assigned and the questions posed.
